1. PRESENTACIÓN DE LA ASIGNATURA

The subject International Education Politics and Policies provides the student with the opportunity to learn about education from an international perspective. It intends to provide students with the opportunity to study in English the key aspects of the pressures in the definition of national education politics from a global perspective. We are living in a complex inter-polar world where education is under the pressure of economic markets. The subject International Education Politics and Policies allows the student to reflect in a new perspective considering at the same time the supra-national, national and local dimensions of education.

The subject International Education Politics and Policies is an optional subject offered at the last level of the Grado en Pedagogía.

- To develop strategies and techniques to develop participation and lifelong education
- To understand education problems, to register, to deal with relevant information to provide judgements to improve educational practice

This subject is connected to the subject Educación Comparada which is taught in the second semester of the third level of Grado en Pedagogía. In addition it is also connected to the subject Política y Legislación Educativas taught in the third year of the Grado en Pedagogía.

- To understand the changing nature of education policies in an international context;
- To read about global trends in education
- To be able to research resources;
- To identify the international perspective in a particular regulation
- To improve students' improvement of writing skills

Aims of the subject:

- To improve the student English understanding in an academic context;
- To analyse an international, European or Spanish regulation in an international perspective;
- To make the student understand changes in the definition of policies;
- To improve the student writing skills in English.

- The changing geostrategy and geopolitics in the 21st century
- Quality in an international perspective: curricular trends
- Education policies action abroad
- Immigration policies

2) Globalisation. Educational policy and politics

- Education modernity and postmodernity
- Tradition vs reform in pedagogical paradigms of the 21st century
- The recurrent debate of diversification vs comprehensiveness in education in global times
- Higher education: state national traditions and the impact of transnational education

7.METODOLOGÍA Y ACTIVIDADES DE APRENDIZAJE

The methodology in this subject is mainly active as students will write a final essay after som research on the selected topic.

The schedule of the activities is the following:

First Activity	Selection and summary of the topic	5 hours	0.5 ECTS
Second Activity	Search of an education policy regulation	5 hours	0.5 ECTS
Third Activity	Writing an essay linking the information in the article with the content in the books	50 hours	5 ECTS

8.EVALUACIÓN

The evaluation of the students will take place through the three proposed activities. In this subject the student does not have to memorise contents in a specific way but has to link theoretical knowledge with implemented educational regulations. This means to be able to identify the pressure of the international dimension in a specific regulation.

1) In first place the student selects and summarises a particular topic out of the ones proposed by the teaching team

The weight of this activity is 5% of the final mark.

2) In second place the student reads carefully the chosen regulation

The weight of this activity is 5% of the final mark.

3) In third place the student writes a personal essay under the supervision of the tutor

The weight is 90% of the final mark
